My teacher doesn't like me.

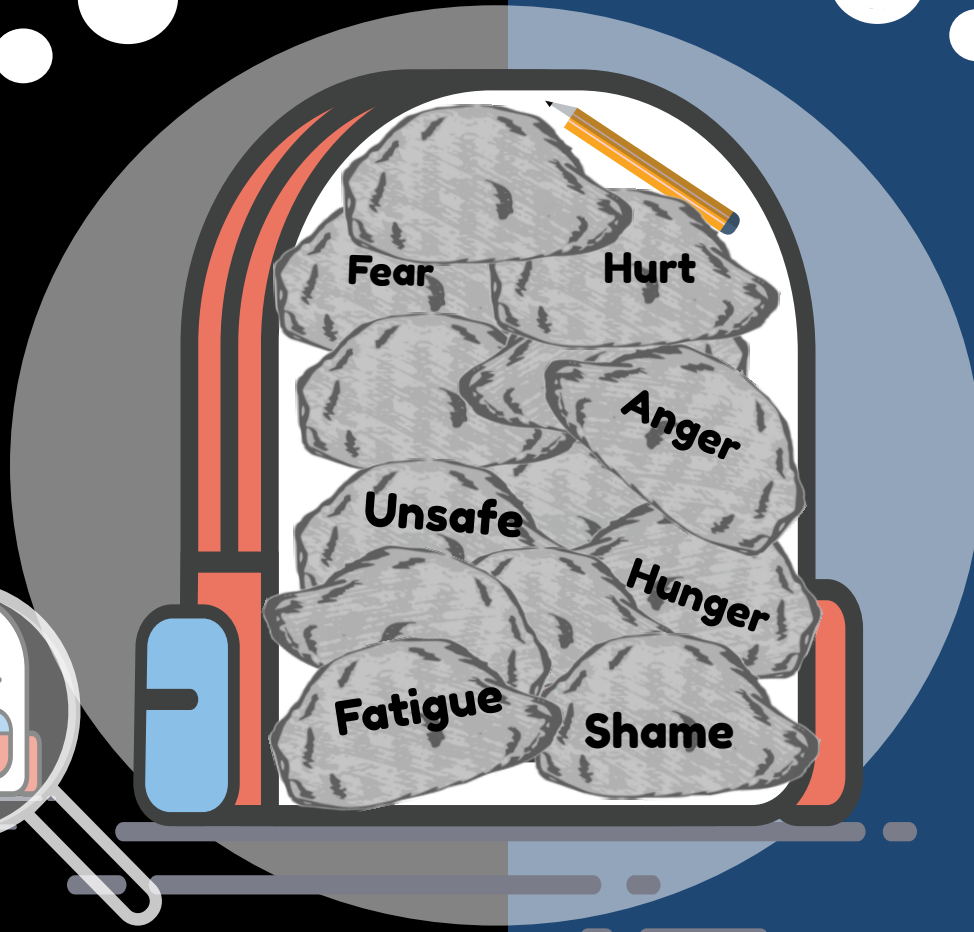
I can't learn.

My student doesn't like me.



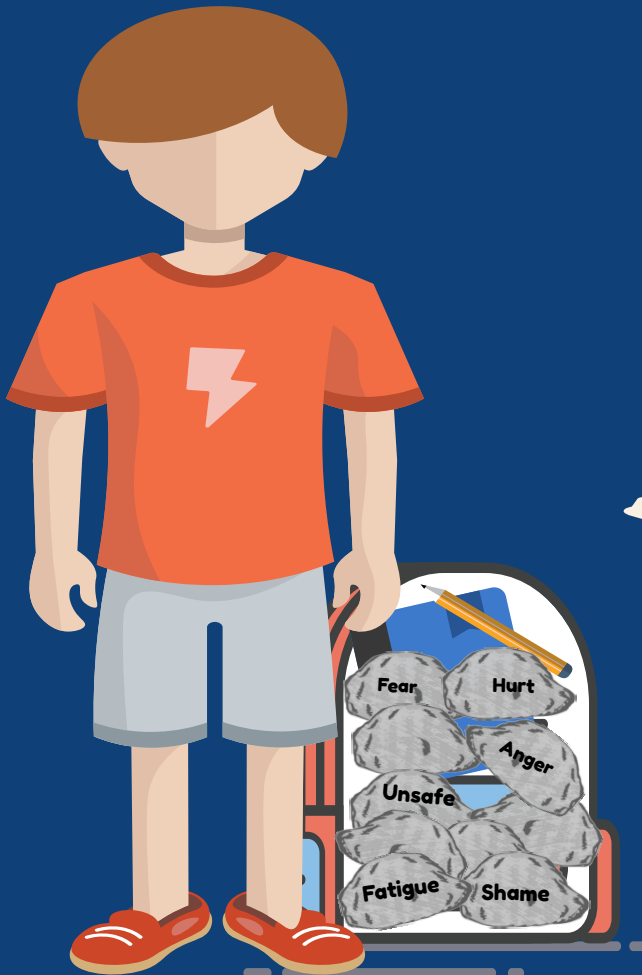
Developmental trauma

A student's ability to show an adult what they are carrying in their backpack will require a great deal of safety, trust, and courage.

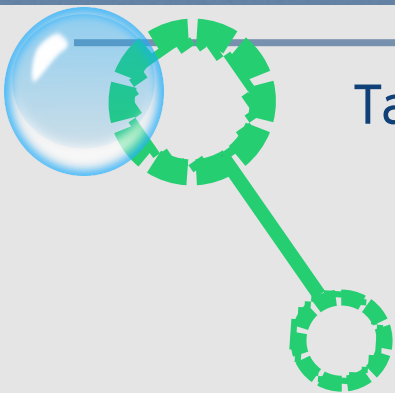


PACE is a way of **creating safety** that will allow a child to recognize their courage and move from mistrust to trust.
